The University of South Carolina Aiken budgets equitably between our men's and women's programs. Our 2014-15 budget was allocated 23% to administration, 37% to men's programs, and 40% to women's programs. Any differences in revenues and expenses are a reflection of fundraising, post-season conference and NCAA tournaments, and use of fee waivers when awarding scholarships. Unspent departmental funds are carried over to the next fiscal year.
