## 11.2 Library and learning / information staff

The institution ensures an adequate number of professional and other staff with appropriate education or experiences in library and/or other learning/ information resources to accomplish the mission of the institution.

Compliance Judgment: In Compliance

## Rationale

The University of South Carolina Aiken employs an adequate number of qualified professional staff and faculty librarians that provide services in the area of learning and information resources. Details pertaining to professional staff in other supporting areas such as department laboratories, computer labs, and academic support units are presented in the <u>narrative response to Standard 12.2 - Student support services staff</u>. <sup>[1]</sup>

Qualified Library Personnel. As outlined in the <u>narrative response to Standard 5.5 - Personnel appointment and evaluation [2]</u>, USC Aiken's hiring process requires that each applicant for a staff position provide a detailed application, resume, and cover letter that address the requirements outlined in the job description. A search committee follows guidelines consistent with university system policies as well as federal and state laws. Applications are screened to assure that the most qualified candidates are invited to interview for the advertised position. Searches for faculty librarians are governed by procedures outlined in the in the <u>USC Aiken Faculty Manual</u> [3], <u>USC System policy ACAF 1.00 - Recruitment and Appointment of Tenured, Tenure-Track, and Non-Tenure-Track Faculty</u> [4], <u>USC System policy ACAF 1.06 - Academic Titles for Faculty and Unclassified Academic Staff Positions</u> [5], and the <u>USC Aiken Faculty Recruitment Guide</u> [6] as specified in the <u>narrative response to Standard 6.3 - Faculty appointment and evaluation.</u>[7]

The Library follows <u>USC Aiken Policy AHR 1.03 – Performance appraisal for unclassified employees</u> <sup>[8]</sup> and <u>USC System Policy HR 1.36 - Performance evaluation</u> for classified and unclassified non-academic staff <sup>[9]</sup> in evaluating the performance and

effectiveness of staff. All classified staff members are evaluated annually as described in the <u>narrative response to Standard 5.5 - Personnel appointment and evaluation</u>.<sup>[2]</sup> Faculty librarians are evaluated annually in accordance with policy governing faculty evaluation as described in <u>narrative response to Standard 6.3 - Faculty appointment and evaluation</u>.<sup>[7]</sup> The curriculum vitae and resumes of library personnel are presented in Table 11.2-1.

Adequate Number of Personnel. The Library provides resources and services through which the institution can fulfill its commitment to excellence in teaching, faculty and student scholarship, research, creative activities, and service in accordance with its mission. [22] As shown in Table 11.2-1, the Library employs five faculty librarians with appropriate degrees from American Library Association (ALA) accredited programs. In addition, the library has seven full-time professional support staff, and an administrative assistant. The library staff is sufficient both in number and in qualifications to support the institution's mission to achieve "excellence in research and creative pursuits" and to prepare students "by challenging them to think critically and creatively, to communicate effectively, to learn independently, and to acquire breadth and depth of...knowledge."

As a measure of staff sufficiency, the number of library staff at USC Aiken was compared to several peer groups. Data from the National Center for Educational Statistics (NCES) were used to calculate the number of faculty librarians and professional staff per 1,000 FTE student for five peer groups. Figure 11.2-2 shows that USC Aiken is exceeds the mean value of a National peer group of 84 similar or aspirant institutions, a Southeastern peer group of 43 similar institutions, and a Peach Belt athletic division peer group of 12 institutions. USC Aiken is comparable or slightly lower when compared to a South Carolina peer group of 13 public institutions and a South Carolina peer group of 10 teaching institutions.

Remote Site and Distance Learning Support Personnel. USC Aiken provides remote instruction for several academic programs on the USC Salkehatchie and USC Sumter campuses, and in the Fall of 2021, USC Aiken will initiate a Nursing program on

the USC Union campus. Each of these 2-year branch campuses of USC Columbia and are members of the USC System. Each provides library services to students on their respective campuses. In addition to having remote access to USC Aiken library personnel, online resources, and interlibrary loans, USC Aiken students at remote sites receive assistance from local library staff. USC Salkehatchie has a qualified Head Librarian [23] and two library assistants, USC Sumter has a Head Librarian [24] and a Library Manager [25], and USC Union has a Library Director [26] on staff.
