## Compliance

Evidence in support of Standard 5.2.a is very similar to the evidence used in support of Standard 5.1, which is expected. Evidence includes the USC Senior Administration Organizational Chart, which shows the divisions of Academic Affairs, Advancement and External Affairs, Administration and Finance, Student Affairs, and Information Technology. The organizational chart demonstrates the Chancellor's control over the educational, administrative, and fiscal programs of the institution.

Additional evidence are the minutes from meetings of the Chancellor's Cabinet of March 2019 and January 2020. An abundance of additional evidence in the form of minutes from various meetings, emails, hiring and promotional documents, calendar entries are used to demonstrate compliance.
