Compliance

The Off-Site Reaffirmation Committee found information from the institution's catalog and the General Education Assessment Reports as evidence of the institution's identification of general education learning outcomes and cyclical assessment of the learning outcomes.

Undergraduate students must earn 50 to 53 general education credits and demonstrate competencies in four areas: 1) Knowledge of Human Cultures and the Physical and Natural World; 2) Intellectual and Practical Skills; 3) Personal and Social Responsibility; and 4) Integrative Learning. General education learning outcomes are aligned with the Association of American Colleges and Universities LEAP objectives. The Faculty Manual describes the General Education Committee faculty membership representing all academic units and its responsibilities for comprehensive assessment of general education outcomes. The General Education Assessment Evaluation Rubric guides comprehensive assessment and actions based on analysis of learning outcomes in general education courses. The institution's Assessment Reports provide evidence that collegiate-level general education competencies are assessed and results are used to seek improvement.
